Simon hunts through online chat rooms, searching for the perfect girl: beautiful, shy, and suicidal. Simon has a particular condition: he is compelled to drink blood. Acclaimed Japanese director Iwai Shunji demonstrates that he is a master of cinematic storytelling in any language.
